Certified Residential Medication Aide (CRMA)

\$300, 40 hours, 5-day course, 8:30am-4:30pm; Add \$80 for supervised medication administration (scheduled separately)

Teaches the skills needed for safe medication administration and covers State of Maine regulations, common medications and side effects, and basic anatomy and physiology. Participants may choose to add supervised Medication Administration provided by an RN and needed to obtain the certification.

Certified Residential Medication Aide (CRMA) Optional Study Group and Recertification Exam

Two days: Exam plus study group \$125; One day: Exam only \$85.

The exam is offered to participants with a current CRMA certification. The optional study group meets on a day prior to the exam.
